Lewis Class: Divided 2 class minimum 60-40%

Special Event: Divided 50-30-20% with the buyer getting 60% and the shooter getting 40%. Minimum bid is \$10.00

100 Straight Jackpot: Has a guaranteed pot of \$100 and will be paid out as follows:

1st time played: 20% of pot
2nd time played: 40% of pot
3rd time played: 60% of pot
4th time and thereafter: 80% of pot

On club day, if the jackpot has not been won, it will be paid out 40-30-20-10% to the top 4 scores.

50 Straight Jackpot: pays out 80% of pot to winner(s).

High Gun Purse: ONE TIME FEE of \$20.00. We will take the shooters' top 6 scores over the season and whoever is high wins the purse. Ties divide.

To be eligible you must have played the jackpot 4 previous times plus club day. If a shooter has not entered 4 times by club day and enters on club day they are only eligible to win the above mentioned percentage with a 100 straight.

Club Handicap Calculations

Club yardage determined by subtracting 2 yards from shooters ATA handicap. Minimum club handicap will be 3 yards less than your ATA handicap yardage up to 20 yards. Non-ATA members will be assigned a starting club yardage of 23 yards and can go up to 22 yards. **SPECIAL EVENT SHOOTERS** will have their Club handicap adjusted after each shoot: add 2 yards for the top score, 1 yard for the 2nd top score and ½ yard for the 3rd top score.

Subtract 1 yard from all other special event participants **UP TO A SHOOTER'S MIMIMUM HANDICAP.**

Ties on all money will divide
